ARTICLE III, Section 1, of the CONSTITUTION OF THE POLICE ASSOCIATION OF CONNECTICUT, as amended, reads as follows:

SECTION 1. Membership. The members of the Association shall be regularly appointed and paid Police Officers of Legislatively constituted Police Departments of the Cities, Towns, and Boroughs of the State of Connecticut; regularly appointed and paid members of the Connecticut State Police Department; regularly appointed and paid Inspectors of the Division of Criminal Justice and regularly appointed Conservation Officers of the Department of Environmental Protection and state agency police officers with full arrest powers who are certified by the Police Officers Standards and training Council in accordance with Section 7-294a of the Connecticut General Statutes; all of whom shall have complete tenure of office. Supernumeraries and Special Officers of such agencies may be elected to membership providing they perform regular police duty substituting for regular police officers and are paid directly from the treasury of the State or of such City, Town, or Borough for performing such service.

No member of the personnel of any Police Department appointed specifically for and engaged solely to perform a specialized service, such as attending school crossings, guarding or attending factory gates, special traffic duties, painters, custodians, mechanical repairmen, watchmen, parking meter collection, matrons, stenographers and similar specialized services, shall be considered as eligible for membership as herein before set forth.

(Explanation)

(Regular members of the Police Departments, such as regular Patrol Officers, Sergeants or those of higher rank, appointed to perform regular police duties and thereafter assigned to or who are supervising the services mentioned above, are by the nature of their original appointment and services as a regular police officer, entitled to retain their membership in this Association).

To the best of my knowledge and belief, the applicant is entitled to membership in the Police Association as his/her position in this Department is consistent with the requirements as are contained in the Constitution and Bylaws of said association governing membership in it.

I further attest that the applicant was not specifically appointed as a member of our department to perform a specialized service as contained in Article III, Section 2, (italicized above) of the Constitution of the Police Association of Connecticut.
